Scrapbooking Entries - Judging Guide

6 Points

2 – General Appearance

- Is it great to look at?
- Do the page elements tell the story? (clean / distressed / other effects)

2 – Impact

- Can you see a theme/ story at first glance?
- Do you know what the theme / story is about?

2 – Colour

- Do the colours enhance the photos?
- Is there a colour scheme?

11 Points

2 – Size & Shape of Photos

- Are the photos cropped and cut to be the focus or to enhance the story?

3 – Balance & Flow

- Is there a use of the triangle, “Z” or “C” design for readability of story?
- Do you see how the story moves through the page(s)?

2 – Harmony

- Do page elements, photos & journaling blocks coordinate?

2 – Proportion

- Do page elements, photos, journaling blocks & title share the page well?
- Does anything overshadow the story?

2 – Emphasis

- Is there a focal point on the page(s)?
- Do you see a place where the story starts & stops?

4 Points

1 – Photo Quality

- Are the photos good quality photos?
- Are they blurred, off centre, etc.

*** Note: Some photos may be displayed this way for effect and to tell the story. ***

1 – Legibility & Spelling

- Can you read the journaling, title & other info. provided?

2 – Neat, Clean & Tidy

- Are there any smudges or left over adhesive on the page elements or photos?
- Are the papers & photos showing clean cutting?
